ANNUAL YOUTH HAYRIDE

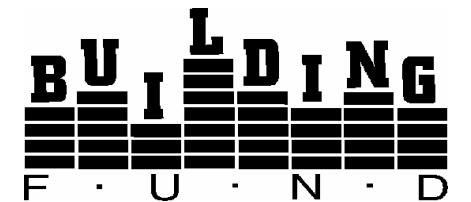
