Dear Church Family,

If anyone from the Bible could identify with the global crisis today, it would be the Old Testament character – Job. Almost instantly, he lost his livelihood, his family, and his health due to circumstances beyond his control. After his friends gave him bad advice and his wife told him it would be easier just to die and go away, Job turned to God. At first, he was angry with God for his misery, asking the Lord a series of “why me” questions (Job 37).

While patiently listening to Job’s complaints, God finally spoke these words, “*Where were you when I laid the foundation of the earth?*” (Job 38:4). In chapter 38, God lovingly explains that He has a plan for all the seasons of our lives and that He is firmly in control, even during dark days. Just like Job, it’s hard to see God’s hands during pandemics and riots. But, when we can’t see His hands, we must trust His heart. If you’re struggling, take a moment and read Romans 8:31-39. Paul reminds us that because God is for us, we will make it safely through to the other side. It’s God’s promise to you.

Last Sunday, we had 144 people attend the 9 am service and 233 attend the 10:30 am service for a total of 377. We also had record numbers visit our Livestream service. I’m grateful that the FBC family is committed to staying connected with the Savior during this crisis. Our worship pastor, David Yarbrough, and I are committed to offering an identical service for those attending the first service. We promise you will not miss anything by visiting the first service.

Please let everyone know that we have two services every Sunday at 9 am and 10:30 am. We have plenty of room for you, your family, and your friends to attend and maintain social distancing. As always, if you’re uncomfortable, at risk, or have been sick recently, please join us through our Livestream. We want everyone to stay safe and healthy.
