

Guidelines to Reopen First Baptist Church

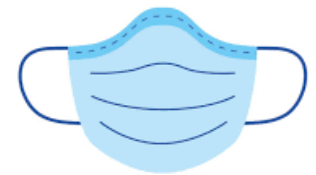
In accordance with the CDC guidelines and the Governor's Office recommendations concerning best practices to reopen houses of worship, these 6 guidelines will be utilized by First Baptist Church as we reopen campuses for worship.

No Occupancy Limit: Executive Order GA-30 states, "There is no occupancy limit for the following: 1b. religious services, including those conducted in churches, congregations, and houses of worship."



2. **High-Risk Individuals:** All individuals that fall within the high-risk group as defined by the CDC are encouraged to stay at home and worship online.

3. **Masks:** Masks are recommended to be worn by attendees.



4. **Hand Sanitizing Stations:** Hand sanitizing stations are located at all entrances to our building.

5. **Hand to Hand Items:** No items will be passed among attendees, including offering plates, print materials, or other worship items. Additionally, attendees should practice touchless greeting (no handshakes or hugs).



6. **Sanitation:** All surfaces and areas will be sanitized regularly with Bio-Protect, a product which is effective against the COVID-19 virus along with other viruses that cause illness.
